We're currently in Tier 1 of Phase 1B of [Washington's COVID-19 Vaccine Plan](#). People eligible to get that vaccine are:

- 65 years or older.
- 50 years or older and live in a multigenerational household.
- PreK-12 educator, school staff or licensed childcare worker.

Those eligible in Phase 1A can still get vaccine, too:

- People who work in healthcare and can't work remotely.
- Medical first responders.
- People who live or work in long-term care facilities.

[Phase Finder](#) is the best way to learn if you're eligible to receive the vaccine. When you register with Phase Finder, you will receive a notification when you are eligible.
